

ACL Leadership Coach Accreditation (1 day)

Who should attend?

This programme is open to all accredited trainers who have at least Team Leader Level accreditation.

Core Content

The one day programme provides the practical tools and techniques needed to deliver effective leadership coaching. As distinct from performance coaching, or executive coaching, leadership coaching places the focus squarely on the coachee or client's role as a leader; their accountability and responsibility for others.

A Leadership Coach encourages individuals to explore their style and approach to leading and managing others using Action Centred Leadership, in order to help them grow and develop as effective leaders. This approach helps the coach to meet both the needs of the coachee as an individual, and, the needs of their organisation.

Programme Format

This day (which runs from 0900 – 1700) is a mixture of input and practical work to practice coaching skills. This includes an introduction to a leadership profile as a coaching tool. There is also the requirement to complete 2 hours of pre-course work and 3 hours of post-course work as part of the accreditation.
